

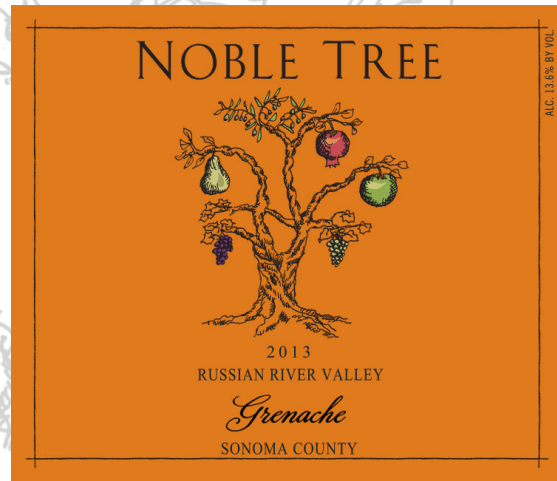
NOBLE TREE

2013 Grenache

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

TASTING NOTES:

Perfumed aromas of rose water and cherry blossom erupt on the nose. This overly aromatic wine has loud notes of ripe raspberry, strawberry and white pepper. Although this 100% Grenache is lean the palate is rich with warm woody red fruit flavors with nice spice and balanced acidity. A tremendous example of an Estate Grenache grown in a cool climate.



WINEMAKER NOTES:

The 2013 Grenache is from an Estate site in the Middle Reach of the Russian River Valley with rocky, sandy loam soils. The clusters were hand-picked, cluster sorted, berry sorted and fermented whole berry in 100% egg shaped concrete tanks. This wine was bottled un-fined and unfiltered.

Aged for 10 months in 100% Concrete Egg tanks.
