

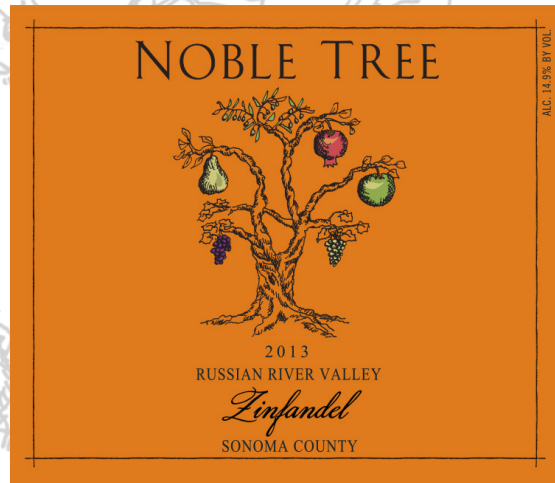
NOBLE TREE

2013 Zinfandel

Russian River Valley, Sonoma County

TASTING NOTES:

The dark, inky, garnet and purple color is followed by abundant black cherry and blackberry fruit intermixed with notes of graphite, spice box and earthy undertones. Stunning depth, full-bodied and opulent, while maintaining a sense of elegance, subtlety and balance.



WINEMAKER NOTES:

The 2013 Zinfandel is from a very rocky site in the Middle Reach of the Russian River Valley and Chalk Hill, and is a combination of vines planted in 1885 (some of the oldest vines in Sonoma County) and 1973. The clusters were hand-picked, double sorted and fermented whole berry in open-top fermenters for 18 days. Punch-downs, instead of pump-overs were utilized in an effort to keep the wine delicate and avoid over-extraction. The wine was aged for 16 months in French oak barrels.

COOPERAGE:

Aged for 16 months in French oak, 40% new.
